It is our Pacifica tradition to have graduates give an oral presentation of their thesis to our community. This year we have scheduled these presentations to occur on the Ladera Lane Campus on Friday, May 23, beginning at 9:00 a.m.

The MA-D group will meet in Room A starting at 9:00 a.m.; the MA-L group meets in Room G, starting at 9:00 a.m.; and the MA-C group meets in Room G, starting at 1:00 p.m.

Track C presenters should arrive in time to join Track L for lunch, served at 12:00 noon. Avrom Altman will host Track C graduates, Tom Elsner will host Track D graduates, and Pat Kasky will host Track L graduates. Tracks D and L presenters and guests should arrive by 8:30 a.m. so that they have time to greet classmates and get settled before the presentations begin promptly at 9:00 a.m. There will be a one-hour lunch break, with a complimentary buffet luncheon served in the Dining Hall. Tracks L and D will be served lunch from 12:00–1:00 p.m. and Track D will break for lunch from 12:30–1:30 p.m.

Each presenter will be introduced by his or her faculty thesis advisor and will have approximately 10 minutes to provide a brief summary of your thesis. Please give some thought as to how you can best present the essence of your work within the allotted 10 minutes. Although this may be a challenge, our time constraints are such that it is necessary to keep these presentations brief. A short question and answer period will follow each presentation.
