A minimum of forty hours are required for completion of the Master's degree with an additional twenty hours for completion of the Ph.D. degree. Latitude is given to students to choose the form of this practice in accordance with their needs and interests. Examples of such practice may include, but are not limited to, individual depth psychotherapy, group dialogue work, facilitated vision questing, rites of passage, meditation or other psycho-spiritual retreat, or artistic engagement.
