Thank you for your interest in the scholarship program at Pacifica Graduate Institute. The average scholarship range is \$500-\$1,500 per academic year. These funds are applied toward tuition in equal installments over the fall, winter, spring and summer quarters for which you are enrolled in full-time coursework (6 units).

Application materials must be completed and returned with supporting documentation to the Financial Aid Office (post-marked) by the deadlines listed below. Late and/or incomplete applications will not be considered.

**Returning students:                                        deadline June 15, 2010**

Pacifica Scholarships are not automatically renewed, and prior recipients, although encouraged to apply, are not guaranteed a continued award. Only the Board of Trustee Scholarship is renewable provided recipients meet the required 3.5 cumulative grade point average. Students enrolled in the thesis or dissertation phase of their program are not eligible for consideration.

To qualify you must complete the following by the deadlines listed above:

1. New applicants must be accepted to an eligible program at Pacifica by **August 1st** and continuing students must be enrolled full-time in coursework (6 units) at Pacifica.
2. Submit a brief essay with your application. Be sure to convey in your essay:
  - any extenuating financial circumstances that you feel should be considered;
  - express your goals and your plans for the future;
  - explain how the scholarship monies will help you realize your goals.
3. Complete the 2010-11 FAFSA form online at [www.fafsa.ed.gov](http://www.fafsa.ed.gov) for US Citizens or eligible non-citizens. Results must be on file in the Pacifica Financial Aid Office by deadlines listed above.

**International Students** must instead of the FAFSA, complete the International Scholarship Addendum (page 2 of the application) according to deadlines listed above along with application and essay.

A Scholarship Committee will review the scholarship application, essay and FAFSA results (or International Student Addendum). Recipients will be selected based on high financial need, academic merit and the content of the essay. Applicants will be notified in writing by August 31, 2010.
