Thank you for your interest in the scholarship programs at Pacifica Graduate Institute. Please refer to the <u>Institutional Scholarships</u> page for all available scholarships and award details. All scholarship funds are applied toward tuition in equal installments over each quarter of the academic year for which you are enrolled in full-time coursework (6 units).

Application materials must be completed and returned with supporting documentation to the Financial Aid Office (post-marked) by the deadline listed below. Late and/or incomplete applications will not be considered.

Newly admitted students — Fall 2019 Deadline: July 15, 2019

To qualify you must complete the following by the deadline listed above:

- 1. New applicants must be accepted to an eligible program at Pacifica by **July 15, 2019**.
- 2. Submit a brief essay with your application. Be sure to convey in your essay:
 - any extenuating financial circumstances that you feel should be considered;
 - express your goals and your plans for the future;
 - explain how the scholarship funds will help you realize your goals.
- 3. Complete the 2019-2020 FAFSA form online at https://fafsa.ed.gov for U.S. citizens or eligible non-citizens. Results must be on file with Pacifica's Financial Aid Office by deadline listed above.

<u>International Students</u> must complete the International Scholarship Addendum (page 2 of the application) instead of the FAFSA, according to deadline listed above along with application and essay.

Institutional Scholarship Programs 2019-2020

Institutional Scholarship Programs

<u>Education Assistance</u>: Offered to new and returning students based on extreme financial hardship and strong academic excellence. Awards are made annually at the beginning of each academic year. The award is \$1,000 to be equally divided over the academic year. For students in the M.A. Counseling Program, enrolled in the 3rd year, the award is \$500. This scholarship is not renewable and students must apply each academic year.

Program Scholarships

Founders Scholarship: Offered to newly admitted students entering the M.A. Counseling Psychology program based on extreme financial hardship and strong academic excellence. The Founders Scholarship will be awarded to 4 students in the amount of \$4,000 and is renewable provided recipients meet the required 3.5 cumulative grade point average.

<u>*Herman Warsh Scholarship:</u> M.A./Ph.D. Depth Psychology with Specialization in Community, Indigenous and Eco-Psychology program.

<u>*Joseph Campbell Scholarship:</u> M.A./Ph.D. Mythological Studies.

*Jung/Freud Clinical Psychology Scholarship: Ph.D. or Psy.D. Clinical.

*Marion Woodman Scholarship: M.A./Ph.D. Depth Specialization in Somatic Studies.

*Global Innovators Scholarship: M.A. Engaged Humanities and the Creative Life and M.A./Ph.D. Depth Specialization in Jungian and Archetypal Studies.

*C.G. and Emma Jung Scholarship: Ph.D. Depth Specialization in Integrative Therapy and Healing Practices.

The * scholarships are offered to newly admitted students entering into one of the following programs: M.A./Ph.D. Depth Psychology with Specialization in Community, Indigenous and Ecopsychology program; M.A./Ph.D. Mythological Studies; Ph.D. or Psy.D. Clinical Psychology; M.A./Ph.D. Depth Specialization in Somatic Studies; M.A. Engaged Humanities and the Creative Life; M.A./Ph.D. Depth Specialization in Jungian and Archetypal Studies programs; or Ph.D. Depth Specialization in Integrative Therapy & Healing Practices. Awards range on average from \$2,000 - \$3,000. The number and amount of individual awards is contingent upon the number of eligible applications received. These need and merit-based scholarships are renewable provided recipients meet the required 3.5 cumulative grade point average.

Students are encouraged to apply for all applicable scholarships. However, scholarships cannot be combined with other Pacifica Graduate Institute Scholarships. Only one scholarship can be awarded per student
