• The Labyrinth: Navigating Challenges and Growth

Phase One **(October 2022 – February 2023)**, the *Listening, Learning, and Connecting Tour*, illuminated our path, fortifying the bonds of our community through open dialogue and reflection. This transformative journey unveiled our points of pride, pain, purpose, and priorities for impactful action. I extend special thanks to my transition team and all

those who actively engaged, including faculty, staff, and alumni who played a crucial role.

Our commitment to diversity, inclusion, and equitable representation remains unwavering. Establishing a diverse, new <u>Executive Leadership Team</u> is a tangible reflection of our dedication to fostering an environment where every voice is heard and valued. Concurrently, we have made substantial efforts to amplify student and faculty engagement across programs by increasing faculty hires, opportunities to engage, and in celebrating the outstanding scholarship across the community. There has been a focus on revitalizing and fortifying relationships, fostering a sense of unity within the campus community, with particular note to the work of our *Clinical Psychology program* over the last year to ensuring its longevity and continued academic excellence.

As we move forward, our dedication to fostering unity within the Pacifica community remains at the forefront of our initiatives. We recognize the importance of repairing and strengthening relationships, ensuring a cohesive and supportive environment that reflects the true spirit of our institution.

In Phase Two **(March 2023 – June 2023)**, we expanded our horizons with the reimagined <u>*Pacifica Extension*</u> division, signaling our commitment to transcend geographical boundaries and engage with global communities. This strategic move fosters partnerships and builds bridges for the worldwide understanding of and exposure to Depth Psychology.

Simultaneously, we initiated our *Shared Governance* work for refining institutional decision-making and established the *President's Advisory Committee and Coordinating-Operations Council*, which unites faculty, leadership, and staff across the campus. Additionally, we completed the first-ever *Faculty Compensation and Workload Study*, addressing inequities and ensuring a collaborative and equitable approach to Pacifica's governance.

As part of the PSP program, we have proactively identified 26 grant-funding opportunities and secured fiscal sponsorship through the Santa Barbara Foundation, further supporting our academic and community endeavors.

As a notable outcome, completing our *Strategic Enrollment Plan* during this phase further strengthens our commitment to academic excellence and student success, ensuring a more accessible and vibrant educational experience.

In Phase Three (July 2023 – October 2023), achieving the first <u>WSCUC-approved fully</u> <u>online PRC</u> and DJO degrees has opened up new horizons, allowing us to share the treasures of Depth Psychology and Pacifica with a larger global audience. The introduction of an Organization Review Study represents a significant step toward a more adaptable and effective future. Efficiency and sustainability are paramount, and launching our Campus Utilization Study reflects our dedication to the environment and resources entrusted to us.

Your pivotal role in shaping our unmistakable global influence is paramount. Recent strides in fortifying public relations have elevated our faculty and student scholarships and propelled us to heights within esteemed academic circles and public discourse. Additionally, our global impact is vividly demonstrated through exclusive events. We hosted the <u>President of Lithuania</u> in collaboration with OPUS Archives & Research Center, cementing our commitment to international partnerships. Further, we were honored to welcome the <u>President of the American Psychological Association</u> as a keynote speaker during our annual Journey Week event, marking yet another milestone in our far-reaching influence on the global stage. Together, these endeavors underscore our dedication to making a lasting impact.

Moreover, our commitment extends beyond the classroom, as reflected in our thriving alumni engagement initiatives. Our alumni, like you, play a crucial role in shaping the narrative of our success.
