Check Request Process


- Send Check Request Form to PA; must include receipts



DISSERTATION OFFICE

- Dissertation Handbooks & forms: https://www.pacifica.edu/student-services/dissertation-handbooks-forms/
- Accepts all dissertation forms from faculty/chairs (Committee member appointment forms, ethics applications, proposal approval forms, final draft approval forms)
- All forms need to come from the student's dissertation chair
- Sends out contracts, via DocuSign
- Must use their PGI email address



DISSERTATION OFFICE

- Keeps faculty up-to-date with student's dissertation milestones
- Pulls quarterly report for Program Chairs,
 showcasing faculty committee appointments
- Lists will be distributed by their program's Chair. We do not send this list to all faculty. However, faculty may email us asking for a list of their specific appointments.
- Works with Chair to determine student's defense date
- Chair gathers defense dates from student's committee members, and coordinates with Dissertation Office to finalize date.
