Dear Pacifica Community,

We would like to share an update on our campus consolidation efforts and the important facilities work underway to support our long-term vision of bringing our community together at the Ladera campus and departing our beloved Lambert campus.

Ladera Administration Building Renovations

Plans are in place to renovate the main administration building at Ladera to better serve students, faculty, and staff. These improvements include:

- Construction of three new classrooms
- Expanded library and student study space
- A renovated archives space on the bottom level
- Modified office and bathroom spaces
- Installation of a new elevator
- Accessibility upgrades throughout the building

These renovations, along with other plans to improve indoor and outdoor spaces across campus, are designed to enhance learning spaces, improve accessibility, and support future growth.

Construction Timeline, Planning , & Impacts

Construction is scheduled to begin at the end of May and will continue through much of the calendar year. During this time, we will be working closely with programs and students to support session scheduling and space planning, particularly as some administrative areas and current classrooms will be temporarily impacted by construction. Academic programs and campus operations are actively working on plans for any residential sessions at Ladera where classroom adjustments may be needed based on construction areas. Communications will be made directly to those tracks about schedules, locations, and any other impacts for sessions over the coming weeks/months. We are also working with any employees whose office space could be impacted and changing throughout the process.

We ask for your flexibility and help as we work together to traverse any obstacles and shifts from the norm. The priority throughout this process is to maintain a safe and serene learning and work environment and to minimize the impact on the campus experience as much as possible.

Looking Ahead

- Through the Fall 2026 quarter, classes will again be split between the Lambert and Ladera campuses.
- Our goal is to have all programs fully located at Ladera beginning Winter 2027, marking an important milestone in our campus consolidation effort.
- Pacifica is working with alumni, faculty, and others on the transition of cohort gifts and other elements of the Lambert campus. More to come on how Lambert will be honored during this time.

We appreciate the community's patience and collaboration as we move through this transition. This campus project marks an exciting moment in Pacifica's history, but one we also recognize carries elements of change, emotion, and questions. We are committed to keeping an open process, with additional updates shared as construction progresses and plans are finalized.
