

CLIE MATCHING GRANT SCHOLARSHIP

The M.A./Ph.D. Depth Psychology program, specializing in Community Psychology, Liberation Psychology, and Ecopsychology, is pleased to announce that Pacifica Graduate Institute will match up to \$12,500 per year in tuition support through a grant. This support can be provided by an incoming student's employer, a non-profit organization, a sponsoring community member, or a foundation. The number and amount of individual awards will depend on the number of eligible applications received.

Applicants should have experience in and a commitment to working in community-based settings or on environmental or cultural issues. The matching funds awarded for the 2025-2026 academic year will be renewable throughout a student's course of study in conjunction with their sponsoring source.

This opportunity recognizes the financial challenges faced by those dedicated to community and ecopsychological work, especially given the increased needs our communities are currently experiencing.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

1. **Acceptance into the M.A. /Ph.D. Depth Specialization in (CLIE)**
2. **Tuition deposit of \$175.00 must be paid;**
3. **Have a financial sponsor;**
4. **Experience in community, cultural, and/or ecological/ environmental work;**
5. **Applicants will be evaluated in terms of merit & need.**

APPLICATION SUBMISSION

Through DocuSign, both the student and sponsor must complete the CLIE program Matching Scholarship Financial Agreement. Please contact the Student Accounts Department to begin the process.

CLIE GUIDELINES

This matching tuition grant opportunity cannot be combined with other Pacifica Graduate Institute scholarships. The matching tuition grant award will be disbursed equally over each quarter of enrollment in each academic year and applied directly toward tuition and fees, thus having no cash value. Grant recipients are expected to be enrolled full-time. If a student is not enrolled full-time, they must petition the specialization faculty for approval to receive a partial grant amount.

Please note: Sponsorship agreements do not carry over into dissertation extension quarters.

Yearly renewal is based on satisfactory academic progress (a GPA of 3.5) at the end of the summer quarter and timely progress through the curriculum.
